
FIRST PUBLIC EXHIBITION FEEDBACK SUMMARY

Kirkstall Place is located at Kirkstall Hill, in the Kirkstall area of Leeds. Artisan, the developer, proposes to create a sustainable residential-led mixed-use development on the site.

On 20th November 2018, a public exhibition was held at the Milford Sports & Social Club to invite feedback on plans to redevelopment Kirkstall Place. This was the first of two exhibitions which will be used to inform the proposals that will be included in a formal planning application.

Local residents, businesses and other key stakeholders were given the opportunity to meet the project team and discuss the plans for Kirkstall Place. The consultation was open to anyone to attend, the event was advertised in the local press (Yorkshire Post) and letters were sent to residents and businesses in the local area inviting them to the event.

High-level analysis of the site and how draft plans relate to the surrounding context were presented to attendees on consultation boards and members of the project team were on hand to answer questions.

Attendees were asked to give their views on plans for the site, any concerns they may have, and provide any suggestions as to what they would like to see delivered. Feedback responses are presented below.

The next public consultation is being held on 5th February 2019 at Milford Sports Club, providing another opportunity to give feedback on the proposed plans for Kirkstall Place.
